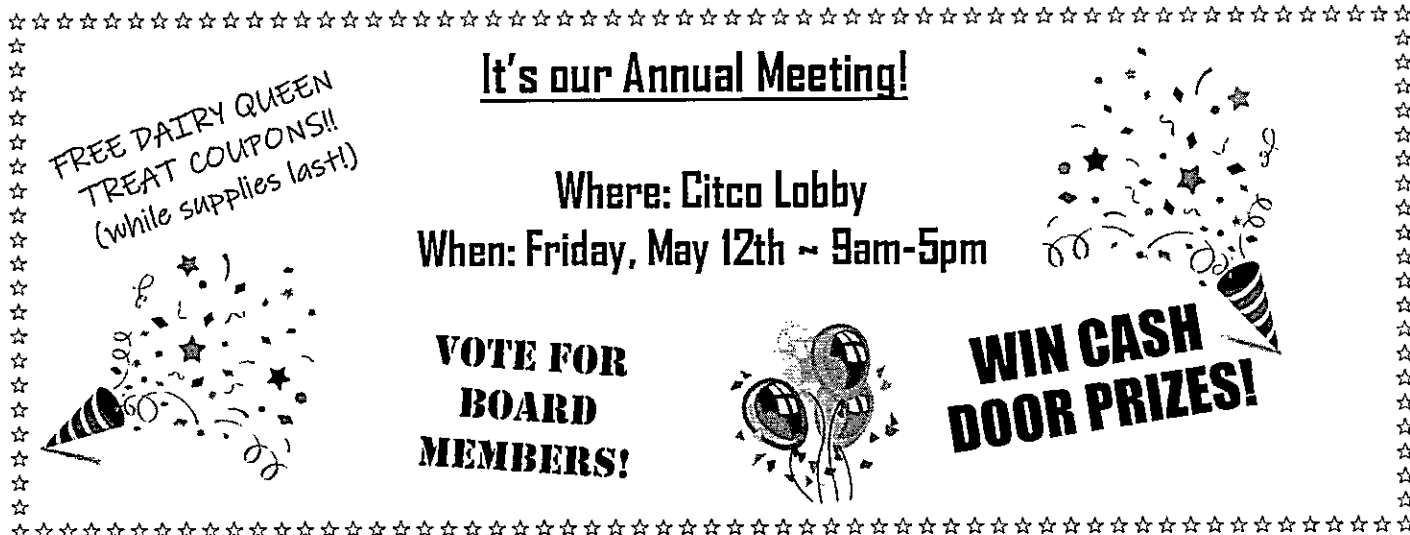

Credit Union deposits are safe.

The collapse of Silicon Valley Bank last month is the second largest failure of a financial institution in U.S. history. The bank was shut down and put under the control of the FDIC following a 48-hour bank run and capital crisis.

On March 12, regulators also shut down Signature Bank.

While this situation does not include any credit union failure, it may still create consumer concerns and questions at credit unions. We want to reassure credit union members about the safety and soundness of their credit union deposits, remind them of the credit union difference as member-owned financial cooperatives, and provide some peace of mind during uncertainty.

As a credit union member at Citco Federal Credit Union, you are an owner of our not-for-profit financial cooperative. Citco's first priority is your financial success, and we focus on financial security.

Citco Federal Credit Union was chartered 59 years ago, and we are committed to serving our community. You can be assured that your money is safe and sound at our credit union.

Credit union deposits in federally insured credit unions are safe and secure.

Federally insured credit unions offer a safe place for credit union members to save money. These deposits are protected by the National Credit Union Share Insurance Fund and insured up to at least \$250,000 per individual depositor – the same as any other federally insured financial institution.

Credit union members have never lost a penny of insured savings at a federally insured credit union.
