Preventing Check Scams

There are many variations of a check scam, but it usually starts with someone offering to:

- Buy something you advertised for sale.
 - Pay you to work at home.
- Send you money to transfer to someone else.
- Give you an advance or installment on money you've 'won'.

To protect yourself from being scammed, keep in mind that even if the check has 'cleared' it may not be safe to spend the funds. If you have any questions about whether the check is good, talk to your banker. Make sure you explain where the check is from, why you are being sent the check and if you are being asked to send any money back.

Do not respond to online ads for easy money. Scams often offer quick ways to earn cash, but easy money is rarely legal money.

Don't be fooled by the appearance of the check. Cashier's Checks, Money Orders, Bill Pay Checks and Business Checks can all be counterfeited.

Verify who you're talking to before sending or receiving any money. It is important to know who you are dealing with when it comes to finances. Be careful accepting or sending money from someone you don't personally know.

When in doubt about the legitimacy of a check, please explain the situation to your banker. Just remember; if it sounds too good to be true, it usually is.
